Inflation Reduction Act projects: climate ready fisheries management



2. Management Integration and Response

- Improve timeliness of integrating updated scientific information into management decisions
- Program review consultant: Conduct regulatory review across RMCs
- Process streamlining consultant: Work with staff to prioritize and develop mechanisms to implement viable regulatory processes identified in program review

FEP Timeline



Oct 2018: Council motion to begin FEP development and establish ETC

Feb 2021: LGL Ecological Research Associates contracted to develop FEP

Apr 2022: Council approves final LGL FEP as a framework for Gulf FEP

Oct 2023: Council approves red tide as a pilot FEI

Mar 2020: Inaugural ETC meeting

Sep/Dec 2021: ETC receives updates and provides feedback on LGL FEP

Apr/Sep 2023: ETC discusses modifications to FEP/FEI structure, FEI prioritization, recommends FEIs

Aug 2024: Council receives Inflation Reduction Act funding to support FEP completion

Fishery Ecosystem Issue (FEI)


A specific fishery management issue or problem that occurs within the Gulf, or a subregion of the Gulf, that may be addressed or solved through Gulf Council action. FEIs provide a structured process to address ecosystem issues that may not otherwise be considered within the single stock management paradigm.



 - Red tide
 - Reducing discards
 - Finfish depredation
 - Impacts of climate change on fish and fishing communities
 - Chasing optimum yield
 - Offshore wind energy

Jun 2023: Removed from

FEI list by Council





- Apr and Sep 2023: ETC explored development of scoring system for ranking FEIs
- Discussed two axes
 - Ecological, social, economic scope
 - Management capacity
- Not yet finalized
